Dear Tuloso-Midway ISD parent,

As we begin a new school year, our students' well-being and success remains the top priority at Tuloso-Midway ISD. Our commitment includes ensuring your child can access nutritious food at school and other points in our community.

Starting October 1, 2020, Tuloso-Midway ISD is operating the Seamless Summer (SSO) Option through June 30, 2021. This federal nutrition program allows us to serve nutritious meals in our community to children 18 and younger and enrolled students with disabilities up to 21 years old at no cost to your family. All Tuloso-Midway ISD students can receive daily meals whether they are learning in-person or remotely.

- Meal service methods available
  - For in-person students: will be able to receive a breakfast and lunch in their campus.
  - For remote students: will be able to receive breakfast and lunch through curbside.
- Curbside location: Tuloso-Midway Middle School
- Day(s) and time(s) of meal service: Monday, Wednesday, Friday 7AM-9AM and 11AM-1:30PM
- Who is eligible to receive a meal: Children 18 and younger and enrolled students with disabilities up to 21 years old.
- Who is allowed to pick up a meal: Child or Parents/ or guardian for child if not present or present.
- What to bring to receive a meal or pick up for someone else:
  - Official letter/email from school listing children enrolled
  - Individual student report cards
  - Attendance record from parent portal of school website
  - Birth certificate for children
  - Student ID cards

In addition to school meals, you and your family may be able to access food through community organizations operating programs such as the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) or Special Supplemental Nutrition Program for Women, Infants, and Children (WIC). These programs can provide additional support during the COVID-19 public health emergency.
