Tuloso-Midway ISD COVID-19 Response Protocol

Positive Cases, Those Actively Sick or
Suspected of Being Sick

Once testing positive for COVID-19, individuals **must** isolate and can only return to school:

- * At least **10 (TEN)** days after symptoms first appeared or 10 days since positive diagnosis **AND**
- * No Fever within the last 24 hours without fever-reducing medication prior to return **AND**
- * **Improvement of symptoms of COVID-19 OR if no symptoms return on day 11**
- * **UIL Athletic and Marching Band participants are strongly recommended to have medical clearance before they return to participate.**

TEA Guidance

Tuloso-Midway I.S.D. must follow TEA Guidance

- Parents of students who are determined to be close contacts of an individual with COVID-19 may **opt** to keep their students at home during the recommended stay-at-home period.
- Parents who **opt** to send their children to school in the 10 (TEN) days following exposure are encouraged to closely monitor their children for symptoms.
- Date of exposure is day 0
- Day 1 is the first full day after your last contact

CDC Guidance

Exposure - Close Contacts

If you opt to keep your child home, follow CDC Guidelines

UP-to-DATE on VACCINES and
Boosters (if eligible) and No
Symptoms

No quarantine unless you develop symptoms. Get tested at least 5 days after you last had close contact.
If Positive begin Positive Case Protocol

Asymptomatic and NOT
COMPLETELY vaccinated (including
booster if eligible)

Quarantine
Get a COVID test on or
after day 5
If Positive begin
Positive Case Protocol

Symptoms Vaccinated/Not
Vaccinated

Follow Positive Case
protocol above
Contact campus when
ready to return
