1. Presentation: Care Portal

Brenda Kelly came in person to present on the new Care Portal initiative – an outreach program in which member churches and various organizations provide support to students and families in need of social services. She was joined remotely by Arlette Vargas. TMISD is the first district in Region II to pilot Care Portal. During Fall 2022, we held a community outreach in which we presented Care Portal and the services provided to support students and families. In Spring 2023, the program will enter the pilot phase. For the 2023-2024 school year, Care Portal will launch.

2. Presentation: Project Turnaround

Jaqi Gutierrez from Coastal Bend Wellness Foundation came in person to present <u>Project Turnaround</u> – an initiative that provides prevention services to students. Services include help with coping skills, social skills, digital media guidance, suicide awareness, and various character education topics. Each campus will designate a counselor to work directly with Jacqui to begin implementing Project Turnaround as part of the district curriculum for Social and Emotional Learning.

3. Presentation: Fentanyl Awareness

Chief Mark Schauer from Corpus Christi Police Department came in person to present on the topic of fentanyl and provided updates on legislative discussions and city prevention measures. Included in the presentation was the <u>Fighting Fentanyl from Texas Health & Human Services</u> and the <u>Fentanyl TEA one-pager</u>. Along with fentanyl, Narcan was discussed as a possible unassigned opioid medication to be used in response to a fentanyl overdose. The <u>TASB FAQ</u> sheet was reviewed.

- 4. Update: Health Services
 - a. Nurses & Student Health Safety

Another <u>presentation</u> was given on a possible lesson plan from the Health Education Services Project.

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b. Social Worker & Family/Community Needs

Discussion on establishing a family resource center. Currently, items like clothing racks and hangers are being purchased to help facilitate community needs. Long-term, items being purchased will be used to create a hub for parents and families to use as needed.

c. Social Worker & Mental Health
